- Memorize **stanzas 1-4** of Robert Frost's poem "The Road Not Taken" in your reader.
- Finish *Great Expectations*, Chapters 46–end.
- Study for the test on *Great Expectations*. I will test you on the following: 1) the lectures that I gave in class (if you feel that your notes are not sufficient, contact other students who have taken better notes); 2) the general content of the book (plot); 3) the characters and their significance. I will also have a reading comprehension section on the test, most likely a chapter that we have gone over in more detail.
- Begin writing your critical essay on *Great Expectations*, which will be due the third week in March. This five-paragraph essay will discuss the novel as a satire on lawyers, money or amateur acting. Your outline will be due next week. I will review the structure of the essay once again in class next week.
- To prepare you for the *Time Machine*, watch a **video** on a scientist who is working on a time machine.
