

## Classic Works of the Imagination, Symbol and Allegory Assignment 5

- Memorize **stanza 1** of Girard Manley Hopkins' poem "Pied Beauty."
- Read Hawthorne's "Dr. Heidegger's Experiment," "Edward Randolph's Portrait," and Poe's "The Raven" and complete all of the study guide material.
- Finish working on your five-paragraph essay comparing the myth "Cupid and Psyche" to Mother Holle. Make sure that you do the following:
  - 1) If typed, double-space your text and use a font like Times New Roman and 12 pt. If handwritten, double-space your text.
  - 2) Write your name, date and title on the upper right hand side of your paper.
  - 3) Include the critical paper grade sheet that is posted under "materials needed."
  - 4) Staple your papers. (They will not be accepted unless they are stapled.)



### Long Range Assignment

You will be writing an expository essay on George Orwell's *Animal Farm* explaining the fable as an allegory of totalitarianism by writing *one* paragraph in which you explain the *work as a satire of totalitarianism* (main idea). The five-paragraph composition will explain how the work is a satire of the principles, government and leadership of regimes such as were present when Orwell was writing his fable (i.e., Nazi Germany and the Communist Soviet Union). You may review the study guide material for ideas. This week you will write the first body paragraph. The assignment will be due **the second Friday in November**.
